**Subject:** LADWP update: Scattergood Generating Station

Dear El Segundo officials and residents,

Following the 9/26/18 Community Meeting, LADWP has taken the following actions to address the community's concerns related to Scattergood Generating Station.

- **A new email address ([scattergood@ladwp.com](mailto:scattergood@ladwp.com)) and hotline (310-524-8609) have been established to handle incoming comments and requests.** The email address and hotline are monitored often and a response will be provided as soon as possible. To ensure proper logging and tracking of all comments, please submit comments via email or the hotline and do not contact Scattergood plant personnel directly.
- **Generating Units 4 and 5 start-up noise:**
  - LADWP is making every effort to minimize the number of startup events.
  - LADWP is exploring possible options that may reduce noise during startup.
  - A consultant will be hired to conduct a noise study during the next startup cycle.
  - Please note that Generating Units 4 and 5 will be offline for inspection from approximately December 8 to 15, 2018. Residents can expect to hear the startup noise in mid-December when the units go online. A notification email will be sent out in advance.
  - Generating Units 4 and 5 will be offline for annual maintenance during the first half of 2019. Residents can expect the units to startup sometime following the maintenance outage when the units go online to meet the needs of LADWP's Power System. A notification email will be sent out in advance.
- **Water tank re-painting:**
  - LADWP is investigating paints best suited for a marine environment, reviewing removal of the paint, and obtaining cost estimates to re-paint the water tanks located near the fence line.
  - A consultant has been hired to determine any necessary repairs prior to painting.
- Cable reels that were being stored in the upper yard near the fence line have been removed. There are a few remaining items that will be relocated out of sight shortly.
- Bushes that were blocking a resident's view near the fence line have been cleared.
