Construction Notice

STREET PAVING TRAFFIC IMPACTS ON IMPERIAL AVENUE FROM VIRGINIA STREET TO MC CARTHY COURT

- WHO:** West Basin Municipal Water District (West Basin)
- WHAT:** Street paving on Imperial Avenue from Virginia Street to McCarthy Court
- WHEN:** Tuesday, March 31, 2009 through Friday, April 3, 2009 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., excluding the intersection of Main Street and Imperial Avenue.
Monday, April 6, 2009, through Friday, April 10, 2009 between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. at the intersection of Main Street and Imperial Avenue, and sections of Imperial Avenue.
Dates subject to change due to weather.
- WHERE:** The contractor will be paving Imperial Avenue from Virginia Street to McCarthy Court.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF THE PIPELINE:

- Construction signs to notify drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking limits;
- Flagmen controlling traffic during construction work hours;
- No street parking on Imperial Avenue from Virginia Street to McCarthy Court in paving area only – restricted parking area will change daily;
- Temporary re-routing of traffic flow on Imperial Avenue during construction work hours, with one lane for westbound traffic and one lane for eastbound traffic maintained at all times;
- To the extent possible, drivers and bicyclists are encouraged to use alternative streets during this work period to avoid traffic congestion;
- Other construction impacts will include noise, minimal dust and minimal vibration.

BACKGROUND:

This recycled water pipeline extension is part of the West Basin's *Water Reliability 2020* program to decrease our region's dependence on imported water from 66% to 33% by 2020. West Basin is extending recycled water pipelines, doubling conservation, expanding education programs and developing ocean-water desalination to protect our drinking water supply. The Imperial Avenue/El Segundo Lateral project is approx. 4,700 feet of purple recycled water pipeline that will protect potable water in the city of El Segundo.
