 - This is a one-time purchase of the program.
- Website
 - Bugs are continuing to be worked out with Granicus.
- Intranet
 - There will be a new line item for the Intranet, separate from the Website.
 - The budget is being finalized.
- Project Reporting
 - ISD will explore different reporting format such as a dashboard or a program portfolio
 with integration of project cost accounting.
