1. CALL TO ORDER

4. REPORTS: Public Works

- a. Hyperion Incident Update: Staff made a presentation regarding Hyperion Update at the 3/1/2022 City Council meeting. As part of this update presentation, Director Sassoon informed the City Council that AQMD had petitioned the South Coast AQMD Hearing Board to issue an Order for Abatement for exceeding the permitted Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) Emission Rate for Flare Equipment. This hearing date is scheduled for March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 9 am and is open to public. This presentation to the City Council generated a lot of publicity. There is a good chance that AQMD will provide a presentation to the City Council meeting on 3/15/2022 regarding Notices of Violations which were issued to Hyperion regarding air quality.
- b. Committee Status and Bylaw Review: The additional comments from the Committee were forwarded to the City Manager's office for further processing.
- c. Form 700 Reminder: Director Sassoon will send an email to Clerk's office and will request another email to be sent to the members of Committee

Member Hawks will create a new poster for printing by Director Sassoon and mounting on a standee by Chair Miller-Zarneke.
- c. Progress with Recycling via Ralph's Collection: efforts to return the "blow-away plastics" collection to our local Ralph's will continue to be made by Chair Miller-Zarneke.
