#### Joslyn Center- May

Outreach volunteers helped deliver a total of 572 meals in May.

#### **Teen Advisory Committee (TAC)**

The TAC held their fifth meeting of the 2022 term in-person at the Clubhouse on Monday, May 2. The TAC leadership team shared notes and information they took from the April City Council Meeting and Recreation & Parks Commission Meeting. TAC members also signed up for volunteer shifts for the Hometown Fair which took place on May 7.

#### **Teen Center**

The Teen Center continues to be staffed and open for drop-in use 6 days per week. Throughout February, an overall of 3,735 teens visited the Teen Center and Teen Center Basketball Court based on the hourly attendance added up for each day of month.

The Teen Center Staff and Teen Advisory Committee Volunteers sold pizza and beverages at the Community Services Department's annual Hometown Fair.

On Tuesday, May 31 the Teen Center was used as a voting center in the Statewide Direct Primary Election taking place in June.

#### Clubhouse

The Clubhouse and its various rooms were reserved/activated a total of 87 times in May for recreation activities and camps, Co-op, meetings, and rentals.

#### **Classes and Camps**

Summer class registration opened for El Segundo residents on Monday, May 23 and on Tuesday, May 24 for non-residents. The Summer Recreation Activity Guide was released to the public on May 11.

#### **Farmer's Market**

Three new craft vendors and one new food vendor will begin mid-June. Summer of Fun will start on June 16th with crafts, bounce houses, face painting and activities occurring throughout the ten weeks planned.

#### Sports- May

Pickleball Leagues are doing great. The season ended on May 18<sup>th</sup>. The summer season starts on June 28th. Saturday's - Pickleball Drop-In program participants number has increased from 36 to 64. Friday's - Pickleball Drop-In program was a success for the mornings, there are 32 participants.
