General Plan Implementation

- State Law does not have specific guidance
- The City's report contains the following sections:
 - Community Development Department activity update
 - Progress on each General Plan Element



Community Development Activity

- 1,827 persons assisted at the counter
- 1,992 building permit applications processed
- 5,313 inspections completed
- 22 planning entitlement applications processed
- 12 Planning Commission meetings conducted
- 232 Code violation cases initiated



General Plan Element Progress

- The General Plan contains the 10 following elements

 - 5. Public Safety

General Plan Element Progress

- Land Use
 - PCC Specific Plan adoption
 - 2021-2029 Housing Element adoption
 - Downtown Specific Plan Update initiated
- Circulation Element
 - Adopted a new traffic mitigation fee
 - Park Place Extension. Initiated the engineering design
 - El Segundo Blvd 0.2-mile bicycle path. Completed design
 - Nash Street Extension. Initiated the engineering design



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Housing Element Annual Progress Report

RHNA progress (Approved Housing)

- 30 building permits issued for accessory dwelling units
- Entitlements approved for the PCC Specific Plan
 - 263 units including
 - 231 market rate
 - 29 for low income
 - 3 for very low income
 - 8 condominium units (market rate)

- City to post application, incentive, and funding information online

4. Inclusionary Housing Ordinance and Affordable Housing

- Grant effort refocused toward R-3 feasibility study
- Developing procedures for streamlining projects (SB 35)
- Progress on Density Bonus, Transitional Housing and Micro-Units



5. Urban Lot Split

- Adopted an ordinance in March 2022
- Developing an application checklist to be posted online

6. Provision of adequate sites

- PCC Specific Plan Project addressed the prior shortfall
- Complete Mixed-Use and Housing Overlay rezoning (summer 2023)
- Develop objective development standards (summer 2023)
- By-right approval for 20% affordable projects (fall 2023)
- Complete Downtown & Smoky Hollow Specific Plan updates (fall 2024)

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- 7. No Net Loss Monitoring (SB 166)
 - Develop a procedure (Q2 2023)
 - Ongoing monitoring
- 8. Lot Consolidation
 - Develop strategies to encourage lot consolidation (Q4 2023)
