





Recommendations

Increase Patrol Beats from 3 to 4

- 42% of Calls are East of PCH
- Growth of Businesses, Schools and Hotels East of PCH
- Larger Crowds (i.e., Top Golf)
- Thefts from Hotels, Plaza El Segundo and The Point
- Increased Traffic







Recommendations (cont)

Hire an Additional 10 Officers (Increase from 62 to 72 Officers)

- 5 Officers (1 Added to Each Existing Patrol Shift)
- 2 Officers and 1 Sergeant Added to Overlap Shift on Weekends
- 1 Detective
- 1 Traffic Motor Officer

Lateral Officer Bonus Program

- ▶ Up to \$70K for Lateral Officers
- \$10k for Referrals from City Employees
- Hire Retired Officer(s) to Assist in Hiring
