The emails will be read to the Disaster Council during public communications and are subject to disclosure under the Public Records Act.

The Disaster Council, with certain statutory exceptions, can only take action upon properly posted and listed agenda items. Unless otherwise noted in the Agenda, the public can only comment on City-related business that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Disaster Council, and items listed on the Agenda during the Public Communications portion of the meeting.

Failure to do so shall be a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of \$250.
