A. CALL TO ORDER – The meeting of the Aquatics Subcommittee was called to order by Member Palmer at 10:00 a.m.

C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Member Davis motioned to approve the minutes from April 22, 2024. Seconded by Member Baldino.

1. Tim Murphy, Beach Cities Swimming

Tim Murphy discussed hosting an Olympic Trials Watch Party at the Aquatics Center pool for Recreation Swim ages 4-5. Murphy requested that this be a co-sponsored event with the City of El Segundo, which will be open to the public.

1. Olympic Trials June 22nd Event

Member Lormans discussed the Olympic Trials Watch Party event on June 27, 2024 from 4 P.M. to 7 P.M. The event will be promoted by Beach Cities Swimming, and normal recreation fees will be charged for the participants.

2. Plunge Update

Member Mancini stated that construction for the Plunge is expected to begin around the middle of August. She is looking into doing a Groundbreaking event, alongside a capital campaign for the June 1st kick off and an intimate fundraising event at Fogo

de Chao on June 24th.

3. Aquatics Center Pool Heater Update

Member Lormans stated that the Aquatics Center Pool Heater has made progress with the design, and that it is roughly one and half months out from implementation.

4. Aquatics Center Maintenance Updates

Member Lormans stated that he has been working with Public Works and Wiseburn to address the shower temperature and water pressure issues.

Member Mancini – Stated that Council had approved an Aquatics Manager position, which will potentially be frozen until mid-year due to budget.

Member Davis – Stated his excitement that Aquatics is making progress towards a complete Aquatics system, and how he is looking forward to the fundraising events.

Member Lormans – Acknowledged the improvement of staffing with increased pay.
