WHO CAN PULL A PERMIT?

A Licensed Contractor and or a Property Owner may pull a permit in the City of El Segundo. The following information indicates the required items that must be available **EACH** time you pull a permit in the City of El Segundo:

A STATE OF CALIFORNIA LICENSED CONTRACTOR

- 1. Proof of identification (Driver's License or Passport).
- 2. Proof of State of California Contractor's License & classification (pocket card).
- 3. City of El Segundo Business License.
- 4. Proof of valid and current Worker's Compensation Insurance Certificate.
- 5. If agent for contractor, you will also need a letter of authorization from the contractor.

PROPERTY OWNER

- 1. Proof of Identification (Driver's License or Passport).
- 2. Proof of ownership (Grand Deed, Property Tax Statement) if recent transfer of ownership.
- 3. If agent for owner, all of the above plus a notarized letter of authorization from the owner (Including owner's Driver's License Number).
- 4. If Trust, need to provide the Trust information showing the trustee.
- 5. If a Corporation, LLC, or Partnership, need to provide information verifying President or Authorized Representative.
- 6. For alterations to the common areas of condominiums, the HOA agreement or minutes for verifying President or Authorized Representative.

*NOTE - A **tenant of a building <u>CAN NOT</u>** pull a permit unless he/she is the **agent** for the Contractor or Property Owner, or has permission from the Property Owner to make improvements to leased space in the lease.
